We are grateful.....

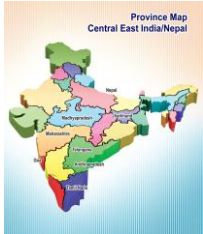

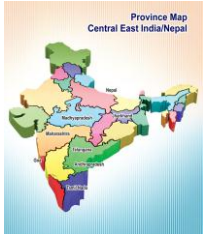
