Good Shepherd Thailand sends a strong message on No Violence Against Women and Children

Good Shepherd Thailand organised a strong advocacy campaign in three locations i.e. Pattaya, Bangkok and Nongkhai.

Pattaya:

On 17Nov, there was a campaign with 450 women and children who walked from the Fountain of Life Centre to the City Hall of the local government carrying slogans and banners to create public awareness. Thereafter, there was a panel discussion with the government attorneys, police officers and governor about situations of violence in Pattaya and how to extend assistance to affected women and children.







Bangkok:

On 25Nov, 300 women and children in Bangkok had their activities organised by the Good Shepherd Sisters and mission partners.



Nongkhai:

A massive advocacy campaign led by Good Shepherd was organised in Nongkhai on 29Nov which drew a participation of 4,000 people and 25 NGOs. The participants were all dressed in orange and processed from five different points into the city centre. The messaging was so powerful that the leaders of the local community have requested for Good Shepherd to organise a similar campaign in the different districts next year.
